Corrections Officer Scott Waggoner didn't think much when he noticed a lesion on his right leg one day in 2007. But a few days later, breathing became difficult and nausea set in. One by one, his liver, kidneys,

and heart began to fail. In a span of about one week, this father of five (with one on the way) saw his healthy body shut down.

Scott now knows the boil on his leg was the first sign of a staph infection. The bacteria somehow entered his blood system and caused severe septic shock.

"That was a scary time. I didn't know if I would ever go back to work," Scott said.

But some of the financial stress of his illness was alleviated by a donation from the MCO Crisis Fund.

Scott made a miraculous recovery. His body responded well to an intense course of antibiotics.

"It was quite a time, but we made it through to the other side," Scott's wife, Katie, said.

An inmate used improvised weapons – padlocks inside of a sock and a shank – in an attack on Corrections Officer Kevin Ott last fall.

Ott and one other officer were alone in a Saginaw Correctional Facility housing unit with 240 inmates at the time of the assault. Ott suffered a broken rib and his right lung collapsed. A piece of his skull broke off, and a blood clot developed on his brain.

Officers and MCO leaders stepped up to help Ott. Crisis Fund money was donated to Ott, and MCO chapters around the state held fundraisers for him.

"Right after I got hurt, I literally got hundreds of emails from staff around the state," Ott said. "They're just great, the people in corrections ... They were very thoughtful. I'm very grateful for what they did. And most of the people, I don't even know."
