





FY '22 BUDGET ADDRESSES RECRUITMENT, WELLNESS

Last week, Gov. Gretchen Whitmer and the legislature agreed on a budget that includes funding for 800 new corrections officers.

The MDOC budget for the 2021-2022 fiscal year includes \$7,373,700 in additional one-time funding for training COs. This means overall funding for training new officers will be more than \$21

million.

The MDOC budget also includes an additional \$800,000 for employee wellness programs, bringing total funding for these programs to \$2 million.

In total, the corrections budget will be \$2.07 billion.

The next fiscal year runs Oct. 1, 2021 through Sept. 30, 2022.

BARGAINED PAYMENTS COMING TO CHECKS SOON

Attendance and physical fitness incentives, dry cleaning allowances, and longevity payments will appear on paychecks soon. See scheduled payment dates at right.

Additionally, the 2 percent wage increase takes effect Oct. 1 and will start appearing on paychecks Oct. 14.

The personal leave grant of 12 hours will be added to annual leave banks and will also be reflected on Oct. 14 paychecks.

These payments and increases aren't just given to us – MCO bargains them. Bargaining isn't free. It takes time and money to gather data on retention rates, wages of corrections staff in other states, and other evidence we need to prepare for negotiations. This is one reason why it's so vital that all members reauthorize their dues by Oct. 2. Details on how are in the story at right.
